



Celabration for Sant'Antonio abate 15 January 2023

The celebration for Sant'Antonio abate, protector of all animals, is in Perugia on the 15th of January, in the ancient district dedicated to the Eremite Saint.

The occasion, deeply felt and attended by the inhabitants of the district, attracts many spectators along the narrow medieval lanes to assist to the official celebrations and all side events of the rich programme. The celebration, in its simplicity, involves actively the bystanders, who become in their turn, part of the event itself.

The benediction of the animals is certainly one of the most fascinating moment for the peculiar atmosphere it creates, exalting the sharing of values as sociality, sense of community, respect and love for animals.

Many the novelties and surprises for all visitors, starting from the naming of the "Piazzetta del porcellino" recalling in the District the regular monks of Vienne. This will turn out a special occasion for a guided tour to not so known places of our Borgo Sant'Antonio.
